'Sponsor-a-Work-Student' Project

As we continue with our daily activities while embracing the New Normal, our work students are faced with a bigger challenge. Much as they desire to finish their education on time, some may not be able to do so because of the following hindrances:

1. Lack of facilities and equipment for online or blended education (Wi-Fi, laptop or android phone)
2. Need for board and lodging
3. Lack of money to buy other school requirements and personal needs

Inasmuch as we want to help them also reach their dreams for a better future, we have come with this initiative – 'Sponsor-a-Work-Student' Project


'Sponsor-a-Work-Student' is a needs-based project which aims to assist our work students continue with their education through sponsoring faculty/staff members who will open their hearts and homes to work students. A faculty/staff can share access to Wi-Fi, lend a computer or laptop, give free board and lodging to one or two work students and in return the latter can help the faculty/staff with certain household chores especially for working parents with kids left at home. This arrangement is hoped to benefit both parties involved.

The following guidelines should be strictly followed:


1. Interested work students shall fill out the 'Sponsor-a-Work-Student' application form at the WSSP Program Office.
2. A sponsoring faculty/staff member can foster one or two work students.
3. If a work student does not have a laptop or android phone, the faculty/staff member can allow the work student to use his/her gadget for online classes as scheduled.
4. For health and safety purposes, students shall stay with the faculty/staff for the whole duration of the Summer Term. This is to be mutually agreed upon by both parties.
5. Work students may do basic household chores or supervise the children especially those with online classes in exchange for the use of gadget, access to Wi-fi, and/or board and lodging.
6. Other services like doing laundry or ironing clothes and the like can be done by the sponsored work students during their free time as long as they are paid for it. (Money earned can be used as allowance for personal needs.)

7. Work students should maintain communication with the WSSP Coordinator. In the event of an accident, injury or any problem that would arise, the student should inform the sponsoring faculty/staff and the WSSP Coordinator promptly. Expenses for repairs of any damage to properties due to negligence by the work student shall be shouldered by the latter.
8. Work students and sponsoring faculty/staff members should treat any personal or confidential information which they may encounter and act in accordance with CPU ethical guidelines, respecting confidentiality issues.
9. Written parental consent for the work student to join the 'Sponsor-a-Work-Student' Project must be submitted to the WSSP Office.
10. Faculty and staff interested in sponsoring a work student can file a request through email at wssp@cpu.edu.ph.
11. Requests for 'Sponsor-a-Work-Student' Project will be approved by the Vice President for Student Affairs thru the Work Student Study Program Office.

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
