4 Likely	Could easily happen; once a month	4 Major	Can result to significant financial losses or can pose a threat to operations and educational service delivery	Offers potentially major significant positive impact on financial/ROI, operations and other business aspects
3 Moderat e	Could happen or known it to happen; once a year	3 Moderat e	Can affect effectiveness and efficiency of business operations in a certain degree	Offers potentially moderate positive impact on ROI/ financial and other areas of business operations
2 Unlikely	Has not happened yet but could; once in 10 yrs	2 Minor	Minimal impact to CPU's business and operations; can be possibly accepted as it is	Offers minimal positive impact to CPU's business and operations
1 Rare	Conceivable but only in extreme circumstances; once in 100 yrs	l Insignifi -cant	No impact at all	No opportunity at all

Notes:

- 1. Risk/ Opportunity Rating, R = Likelihood (L) x Severity (S)
- 2. Risk Level/Opportunity Level, ROL = Risk/Opportunity Rating (R) Existing Control (EC)
- 3. Thresholds:

Significant Risk Level = 9. If more than 9, and any S = 5, need action plan to address risks and opportunities

Significant Opportunity Level = 12. If more than 12, opportunity is considered to be pursued by concerned management
